Tanznacht Berlin 2016 Gefährten 27.–29. August

From August 27th through August 29th, the 9th edition of Tanznacht Berlin will present the current position of Berlin's artists over the course of 23 events and a wide range of choreograhies, durational performances, installations and dialog formats, including 6 world premieres, 2 German premieres, and 2 Berlin premieres. Tickets are available now!

Hosted by Tanzfabrik Berlin, this year's edition of the biennial festival for contemporary dance from Berlin focuses on the connections created through contemporary artistic practices. Which other expressive forms is movement set in dialogue with? In what other forms does it appear? And how is it understood. What approaches does movement take that that result in new perspectives on a societal sense of togetherness? The festival deals with *Gefährten* (companions), or equally matched alliances that are sought out and serve to turn dance and performance into a social art form. Over the course of 23 events, this year's edition of the established platform for contemporary dance at Uferstudios traces this question of companionship in choreographies, performances, installations, and dialog formats, including six world premieres, two German premieres, and two Berlin premieres.

With "Voicing Pieces" by Begüm Erciyas and Matthias Meppelink, "Between what is no longer and what is yet" by Juan Dominguez, the speech act format "SAY SOMETHING" by and with Antonia Baehr, Agata Siniarska, Jeremy Wade and Siegmar Zacharias, "To Meet" by Alice Chauchat invites Louise Trueheart, the lecture performance "Just in Time - Letters to Dance. Ein Tanzfonds Erbe Projekt" by deufert&plischke, Miriam Jakob, Lee Méir, Kareth Schaffer and "walk+talk berlin," a project in cooperation with Tanz im August by and with Maria F. Scaroni, Kat Válastur (Tanznacht Berlin), Sidney Leoni and Sebastian Matthias (Tanz im August), as well as "Kumpane mit Brot" by Beide Messies, Tanznacht Berlin will present six world premieres. The performances "Très bien éclairé" by Arantxa Martinez and "Operation Orpheus" by Jule Flierl will be shown for the first time ever in Germany. Colette Sadler, with "Notebooks Series," and Alexandre Achour, with "Speaking about the ghost," will celebrate their Berlin premieres.

Berlin choreographer **Jared Gradinger** dedicates himself to the cycle of coming and going, to human and nature with his garden installation the "Impossible Forest," which we started to create in March. Since then, it continues to flourish and on Saturday, August 27th at 7 PM, it will officially open with the "Procession of the Flower Children," a workshop and choir project by Gradinger and filmmaker **Liz Rosenfeld** with children, and at 10 PM with a concert by **Otis Sun**.

Performances across multiple hours, as well as performance installations invite audiences to visit more than just once: "TITLE" by **Public in Private/Clément Layes**, a further development of his newest work for the stage; the first version of the production "Bounty" by **Sheena McGrandles** and **Claire Vivianne Sobottke**; and a premiere by the performance duo **Beide Messies**.

Thomas Lehmen will build his own station in the yard at Uferstudios where he will give two visitors at a time an intro into the art of giving in "A Piece for You – Report for Two." Berlin will also see the return of: "TRUCKERS AND TRACKERS. Alien unmade" by **Frauke Havemann/ON AIR**; "Don't recognize me" by **Hanna Hegenscheidt**; **Peter Pleyer's** "Ponderosa Trilogy"; as well as **Kokana Šanić Koka aka Dragana Bulut's** further development of "ARCHIV ARBEIT VI"; and **Ligia Lewis'** "Sorrow Swag."

The video performance installation "t r a c i n g" by **Ayara Hernández Holz/ LUPITA PULPO** is a composition made up of recorded conversations in which interview partners describe the most powerful experience they have had in a theater. **Diego Agulló** invites artists and spectators to his "INTERPLAY. Measuring the temperature of Dance," a series of conversations on the works shown during Tanznacht Berlinl and on Monday, August 29th, Tanznacht Berlin, the Dachverband Tanz Deutschland, the Tanzbüro Berlin and the Verband zeitgenössischer Tanz Berlin e.V. welcome audience members to podium discussions with choreographers, curators, and journalists under the title "**Dance vs. Circumstances**" (working title) in order to exchange views on current collective artistic working methods and adequate production conditions.
